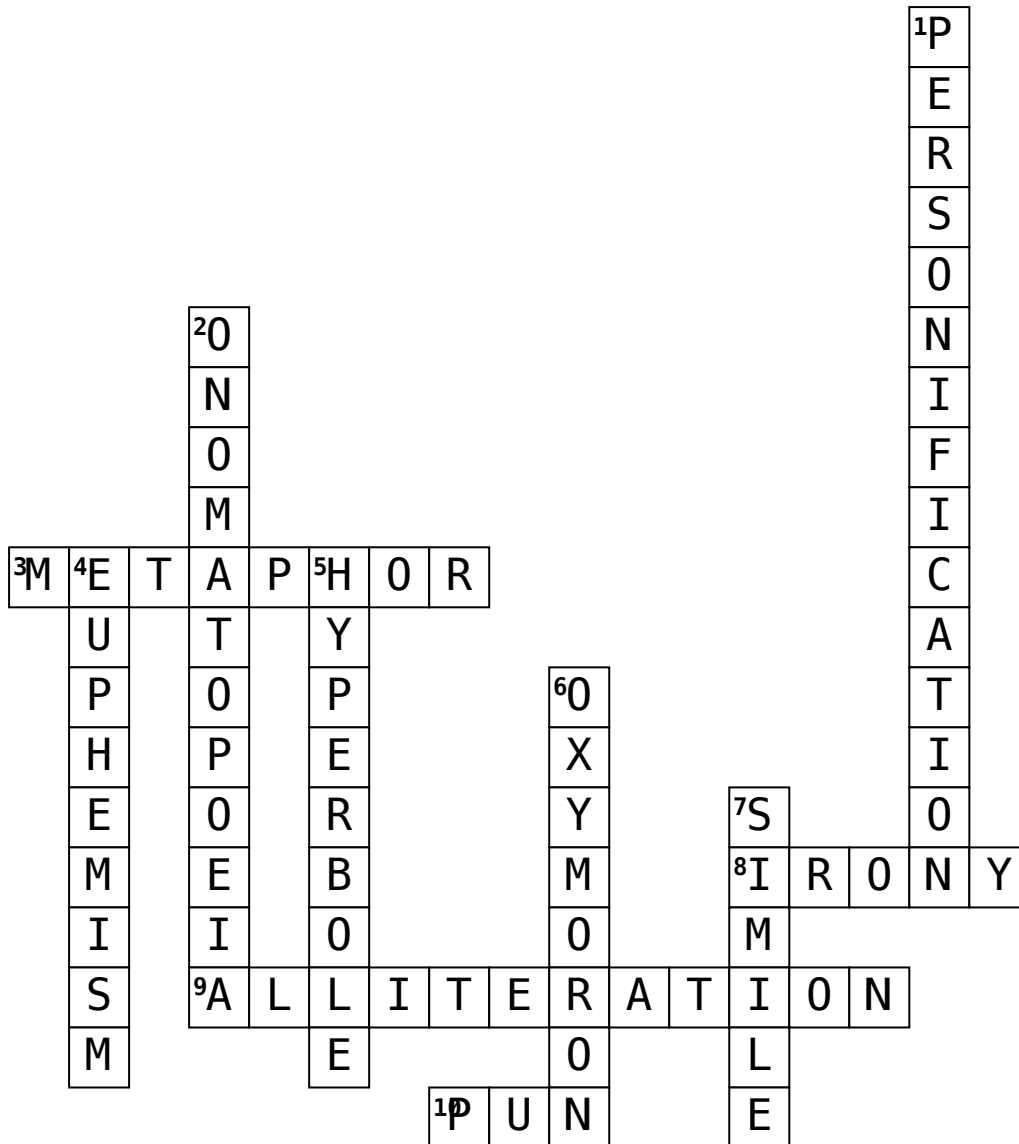


Figures of Speech Crossword

- 5.** A deliberate and massive exaggeration used for dramatic or humorous emphasis.
- 6.** A figure of speech that pairs two completely contradictory terms together.
